User Guide

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Introduction

Magikrolta Theme is a Magento theme with administrative module, suitable for every type of store.

It was designed with focus on user experience and usability, to make Magento shopping quick, easy and fun. It is equipped with a dedicated administrative module, which brings all the features necessary for successful online store – all at the command of a few key strokes.

1. Quick start

1.1 Installation

To install Rolta Theme you only need to take a few quick steps:

1. Install Magikrolta Theme: **2. Installation**
2. Clear and disable Magento cache: **3.1 Caching system**
3. Enable Magikrolta Theme **3.2 Enable Magikrolta Theme**

1.2 Configuration

Next, you need to configure your store. Magikrolta Theme works “out of the box”, but not all of the features are enabled by default. You might want to take the following steps:

2. Upload your logo: **3.5 Logo**
3. Configure your home page: **3.3 Home page**
4. Create some static blocks to display your custom content: **5. Static blocks**

1.3 Fresh install

If you have just installed a fresh copy of Magento you should also:

1. Create categories: **3.6 Categories**

1.4 Demo products

To install demo products and categories you can use the sample data from the official Magento site (it must be installed prior to the basic Magento installation):

2. Installation

1. Log out from Magento admin panel – **do not omit this step**.
2. Using your FTP client (like FileZilla) go to your Magento root directory (it is the directory on your server where Magento is installed). Clear the store cache in **var/cache** directory (delete all the files inside). Do not delete **var/cache** folder! It's necessary since Magento uses cache heavily.

Next, delete all cookies for your store domain in your web browser. All these steps will eliminate most of potential problems.

3. Backup the store database and all Magento files.

Important:

Backup is extremely important, especially if you are working on a live store.

4. Extract the theme contents on your computer and navigate inside the extracted folder.
5. Navigate inside **Theme** directory. Using your FTP client upload content of **Theme** directory to your Magento root directory.

Note:

This will not overwrite any files, just add the theme.

6. That's all. Now you can log in to Magento admin panel to enable and configure your new Magento theme.

If you encounter any problems after installation of the theme: log out from Magento admin panel, clear the store cache under **var/cache**, and log in again. If it does not help, please refer to **6. Troubleshooting** chapter.

3. Configuration

3.1 Caching system

When developing your Magento store, you want to see the changes you have implemented. In order to be able to see changes, you need to **disable caching system**. To access the cache management screen go to *System > Cache Management*. Click **Select All** link, select **Disable** in **Actions** field and click **Submit** button:

When the store is configured you can enable caching system again. After extension installation, upgrade or uninstallation, always refresh the cache. To do this, click **Select All** link, select **Refresh** in **Actions** field and click **Submit** button:

3.2 Enable Magikrolta Theme

To enable the Magikrolta Theme after installation go to *System > Configuration > Design* section.

Note:

If you want to change the look of your entire site, make sure you select **Default Config** under **Current Configuration Scope**. Otherwise, set the scope according to your needs.

Go to **Themes** tab and enter **rolta** in the **Default** field. Click **Save Config** button.

3.3 Enable Magikrolta Home page

To enable Magikrolta theme home page, go to System > Configuration > Web section.

Note:

If you want to change the look of your entire site, make sure you select **Default Config** under **Current Configuration Scope**. Otherwise, set the scope according to your needs.

Go to **Default Pages** tab and select CMS Home page as **Rolta Home Page**. Click **Save Config** button.

3.3.1 404 No Route Page

To enable Magikrolta theme 404 no route page, go to **Default Pages** tab and select CMS No Route Page as **Rolta 404 No Route Page**. Click **Save Config** button.

3.4 Home Page

Magikrolta Theme home page design is very simple. In this chapter you can find a short description of the blocks which you can use on your home page. To edit home page, go to *CMS > Pages > Rolta Home page*. Insert your content in the main field in *Content* tab:

3.4.2 Home page blocks

The following blocks can be displayed on your home page:

- **Featured Product slider** – slider can display products which are marked as featured in store. To display this block add the following code to the home page content:

<div class="home-slider">{{block type="catalog/product_list" num_products="xx" category_id="xx" name="featuredproduct" as="featuredproduct" template="catalog/product/featured.phtml" }}</div>

Replace **xx** with proper values of the parameters:

- **category_id** – specify ID of the category which you want to display.
- **num_products** – specify the number of products to display.

Note: Remember to replace **xx** with proper values of the parameters.

To display featured products on home page . Go to **Catalog -> Manage Products**
Edit any product under General tab "Featured Product on Home" set to "Yes"

- **Bestseller Products** – with this block you can display products which are sell.

- **num_products** – specify number of displayed products.
- **category_id** – specify ID of the category which you want to display.

Note: Remember to replace **xx** with proper values of the parameters.

- **RHS Banner** – simple image banners block. To edit RHS image banner block, go to CMS > Static Blocks > Rolta Home RHS Banner Block.

Adjust it to your liking, add links etc.

3.5 Logo

Upload your logo (28 pixels high, any width) to *skin/frontend/default/rolta/images/* directory. By default Magento displays logo named **logo.png**. If you are using different file name or different file format (e.g. *.jpg* or *.png*) go to *CMS > Static Blocks > Rolta Store Logo > Content* section and upload logo.

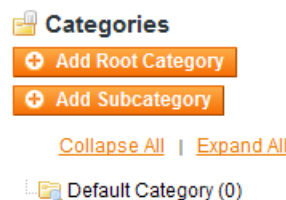

3.6 Categories

To create and edit categories, navigate to *Catalog > Manage Categories*. After Magento installation your category tree is almost empty, there is only the root category (named **Default Category**):



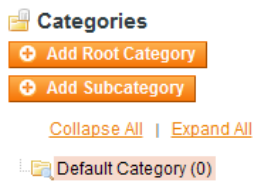
The root category is not displayed on the frontend of your store – **that's why your main menu is empty** just after Magento installation. You need to add some subcategories of the root category.

Note: All subcategories have to be **descendants** of the root category.

To add a new subcategory, select the root category by clicking on it and click **Add Subcategory** button:



Fill in all the required fields. Especially set **Is Active** and **Include in Navigation Menu** fields to **Yes**, and click **Save Category**:

3.7 Localization

3.7.1 Interface translation

If you want to change additional interface character strings. For example “Special Price” label is replaced with shorter “Now only” label. Strings are located in *app/design/frontend/default/default/locale/en_US/translate.csv*. This file can be used to translate the interface into other languages.

Example

To translate the interface into spanish follow these instructions:

- Create a new folder for your translation. For spanish language it will be *app/design/frontend/default/rolta/locale/es_ES*.
- Copy *translate.csv* from *app/design/frontend/default/default/locale/en_US* and paste it into created folder *app/design/frontend/default/rolta/locale/es_ES*.
- Open *app/design/frontend/default/rolta/locale/es_ES/translate.csv* in OpenOffice Calc (or other text editor like Notepad++, PSPad).

Note:

The editor should be capable to save file in UTF-8 encoding. Do not use Excel, it can break file structure.

- If you open *translate.csv* in OpenOffice Calc it might look like this:

The first column contains the original character strings. It should be **left intact**. In the second column you can place your translation of each string.

- Some strings contains %d or %s entries. These entries should be **left intact** in the translated strings.

4. Theme Admin module usage

Magikrolta Theme is equipped with **Theme Admin** module which offers a variety of additional features. Go to *System > Configuration > Magik Rolta > Theme settings* section to configure theme's settings.

4.1 Appearance

In this tab, you can modify the visual experience of the store.

- **Width** – Here you can change the theme width from fixed to flexible width.
- **Footer** – set simple or informative footer.
- **Font** – Here you can change the theme font.
- **Theme Color** – This color will be used for buttons.
- **Header BG Color** – This color will be used for header background.
- **Header Text Color** – This color will be used for header text/links.
- **Footer BG Color** – This color will be used for footer background.
- **Footer Text Color** – This color will be used for footer text/links.
- **Content BG Color** – This color will be used for content background.

4.2 Header


In this tab, you can set options related to the header section of the store.

- **Home Link in Navigation** – if set to **Yes**, will show a text link to the home page in the main navigation menu.

4.3 Footer

In this tab, you can set google analytics code to footer.

- **Google Analytics in footer** – if set to **Yes**, will enable google analytics code in footer.
- **Google Analytics** – here you can paste google analytics code.

4.4 Social Links

In this tab, you can set social links.

- **Enable all Social Links** – if enabled, social links will be displayed.
- **Enable Facebook Social Link** – if enabled, facebook social link will be displayed.
- **Facebook Link Path** – Link for facebook.
- **Enable Twitter Social Link** – if enabled, Twitter social link will be displayed.
- **Twitter Link Path** – Link for twitter.
- **Enable GooglePlus Social Link** – if enabled, GooglePlus social link will be displayed.
- **GooglePlus Link Path** – Link for googleplus.
- **Enable RSS Social Link** – if enabled, RSS social link will be displayed.
- **RSS Link Path** – Link for rss.
- **Enable Pinterest Social Link** – if enabled, Pinterest social link will be displayed.

- **Pinterest Link Path** – Link for pinterest.
- **Enable Linkedin Social Link** – if enabled, Linkedin social link will be displayed.
- **Linkedin Link Path** – Link for linkedin.
- **Enable Youtube Social Link** – if enabled, Youtube social link will be displayed.
- **Youtube Link Path** – Link for youtube.

4.5 Products

In this tab, you can set products to detail page.

- **Upsell Products in detail page** – Upsell products block in Magento is enabled by default, but here you can disable it. It can sometimes be useful.
- **Related Products in detail page** – Related products block in Magento is enabled by default, but here you can disable it. It can sometimes be useful.

- **Next Previous Products in detail page** – if enabled, next previous products section will be displayed.

4.6 Shopping Cart

In this tab, you can set shopping cart in header.

- **Display Shopping Cart at top** – if set to **Yes**, will show a shopping cart in header.

5. Static blocks

There are 13 predefined static blocks in the store, ready to display anything you want. Just create one of the blocks and insert your content: image banner, info about contacts, footer links etc. No coding needed, everything edited from admin panel.

All available predefined block's identifiers are described later in this chapter. E.g. `rolta_footer_links` is an identifier of a block which displays links in the footer. So if you create a static block with identifier `rolta_footer_links`, the content of that block will be displayed in the footer of the store.

5.1 How to create a static block?

To start using any predefined static block, go to *CMS > Static Blocks > Add New Block* and follow these steps:

1. In **Identifier** field enter an identifier of one of the predefined static blocks. Make sure the identifier is all lower-case and separated by underscores to follow Magento's standards.
2. Enter the title in **Block Title**.
3. Select the **Store View** to which this block will apply.
4. Select Enabled in the **Status** field. Disabled means that the block is not displayed in the frontend.
5. Insert your **Content**. It can be text or HTML format.
6. Click **Save Block**.

Let's see an example. To place Custom Block in the navigation menu at the end of the store navigation you can use one of the predefined static blocks. Create a new block with identifier `rolta_navigation_block`, insert your content and click **Save Block**. As a result you will get a block placed at the end of the store navigation. Here you can see the completed form:

5.2 Static block content templates

In each block you can insert any content you want, but using the proposed templates will help you to keep the design consistent. E.g. in all blocks containing links you can use the following HTML template, which will set CSS classes "first" and "last" for the first and the last link on the list:

5.2.1 CMS markup tags

There are some special markup tags – a bit of text surrounded by double curly braces – which have a special meaning in Magento.

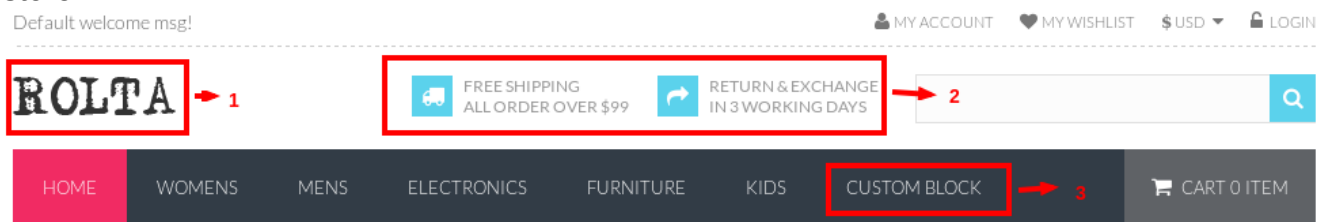

5.3 Magikrolta Theme static blocks

Below you can find all the predefined static block identifiers available in Magikrolta Theme. You can use them to create static blocks which will be placed in the most important regions of the store. Positions of those blocks are shown on the screenshots. For static block path refer to **5. Static Blocks** chapter.

5.3.1 Header

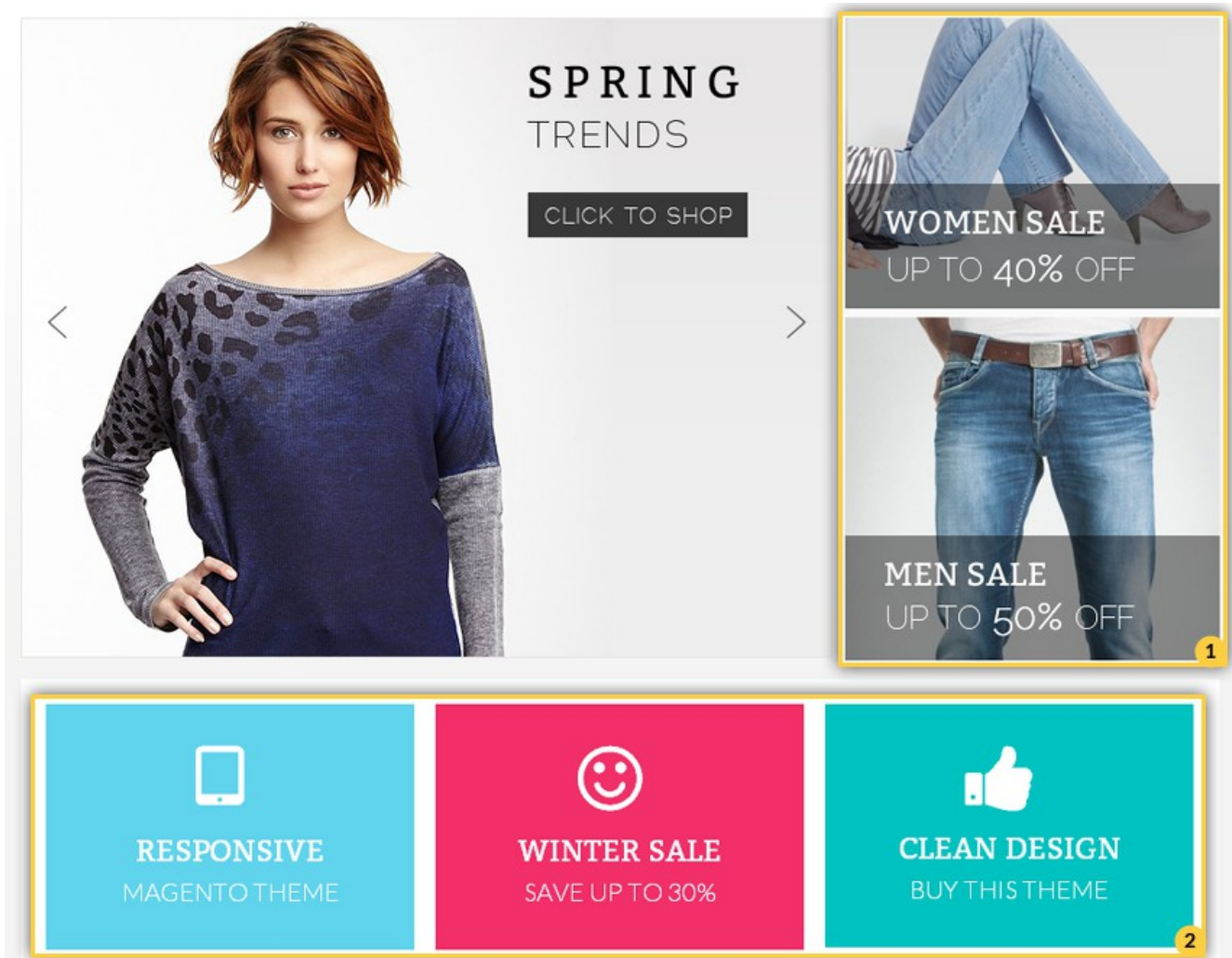
The following block identifiers can be used to display blocks in the header section of the store:



1. [rolta_logo](#) – contains theme logo.
2. [rolta_header_free_shipping_block](#) – static block in header.
3. [rolta_navigation_block](#) – drop-down block in the main menu.

5.3.2 Home page content section blocks

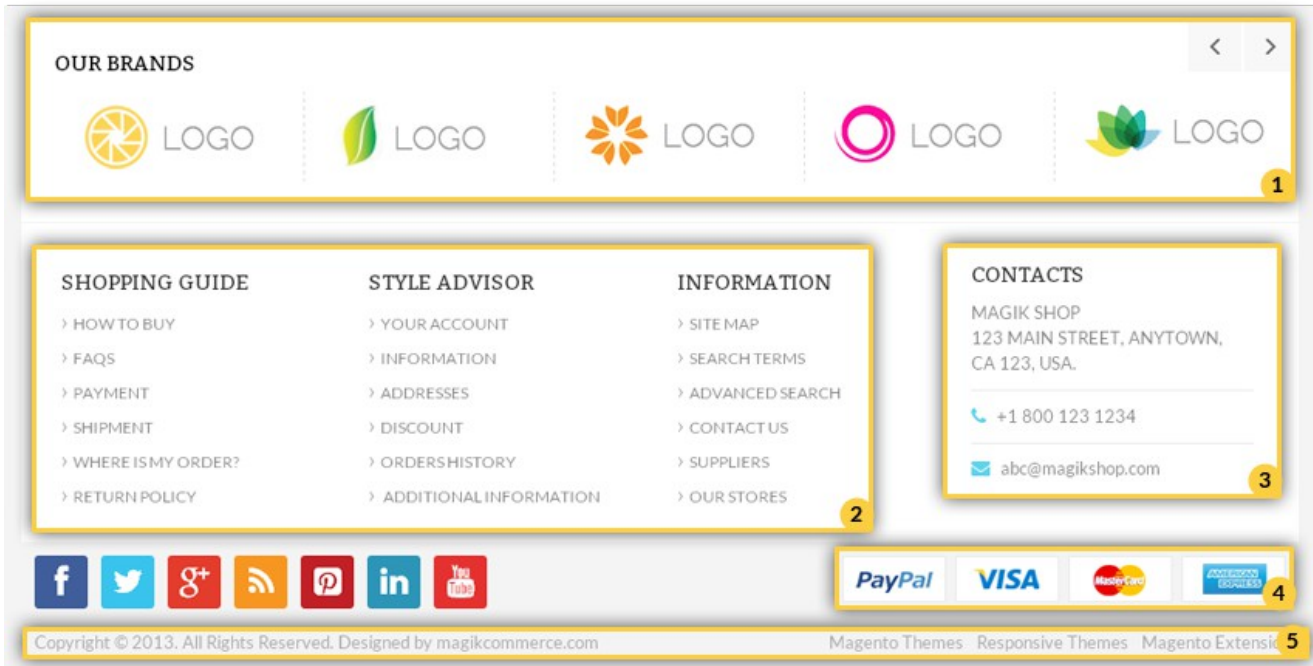
The following block identifiers can be used to display blocks in the content section of the store home page:



1. **rolta_home_rhs_banner_block** – block at the right edge of slideshow.
2. **rolta_home_banner_block** – block at the bottom of the slideshow.

5.3.3 Footer

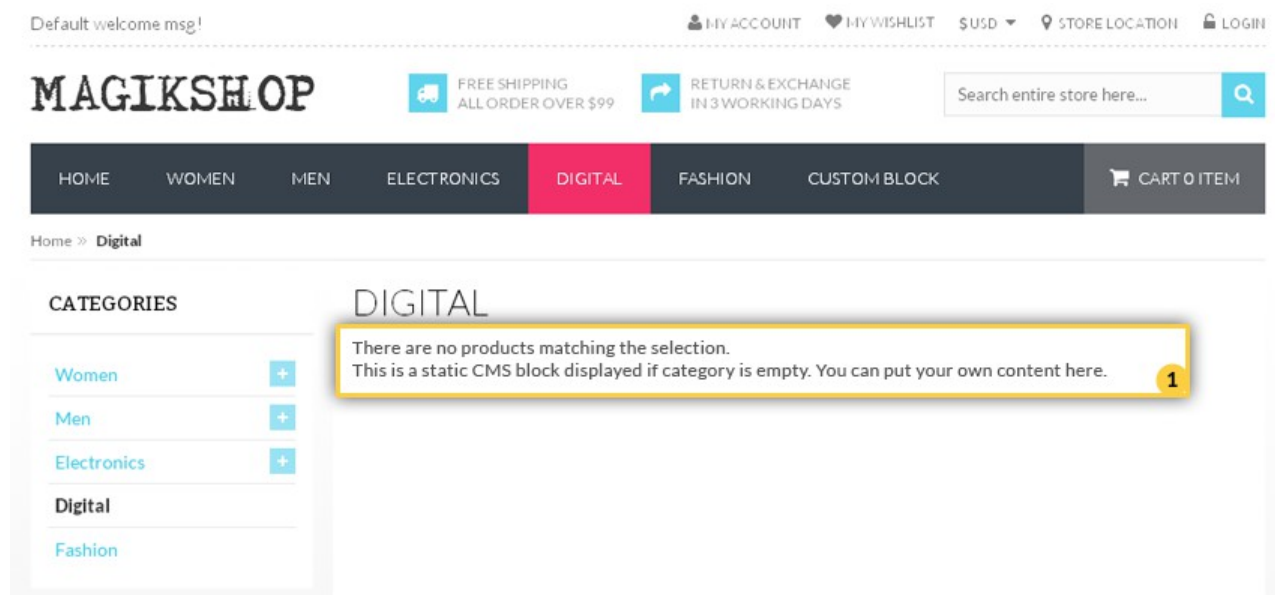
The following block identifiers can be used to display blocks in the footer section of the store:



1. [rolta_logo_brand_block](#) – defines brand logos, here you can change logo brand images as per your store.
2. [rolta_footer_information_links_block](#) – defines footer links.
3. [rolta_footer_contacts](#) – information about company, address, phone number, email address etc.
4. [rolta_footer_payment_block](#) – information about payment methods, credit cards, SSL certificates etc.
5. [rolta_footer_links](#) – themes copyright section.

5.3.4 Category view

The following block identifiers can be used to display blocks in the category view:

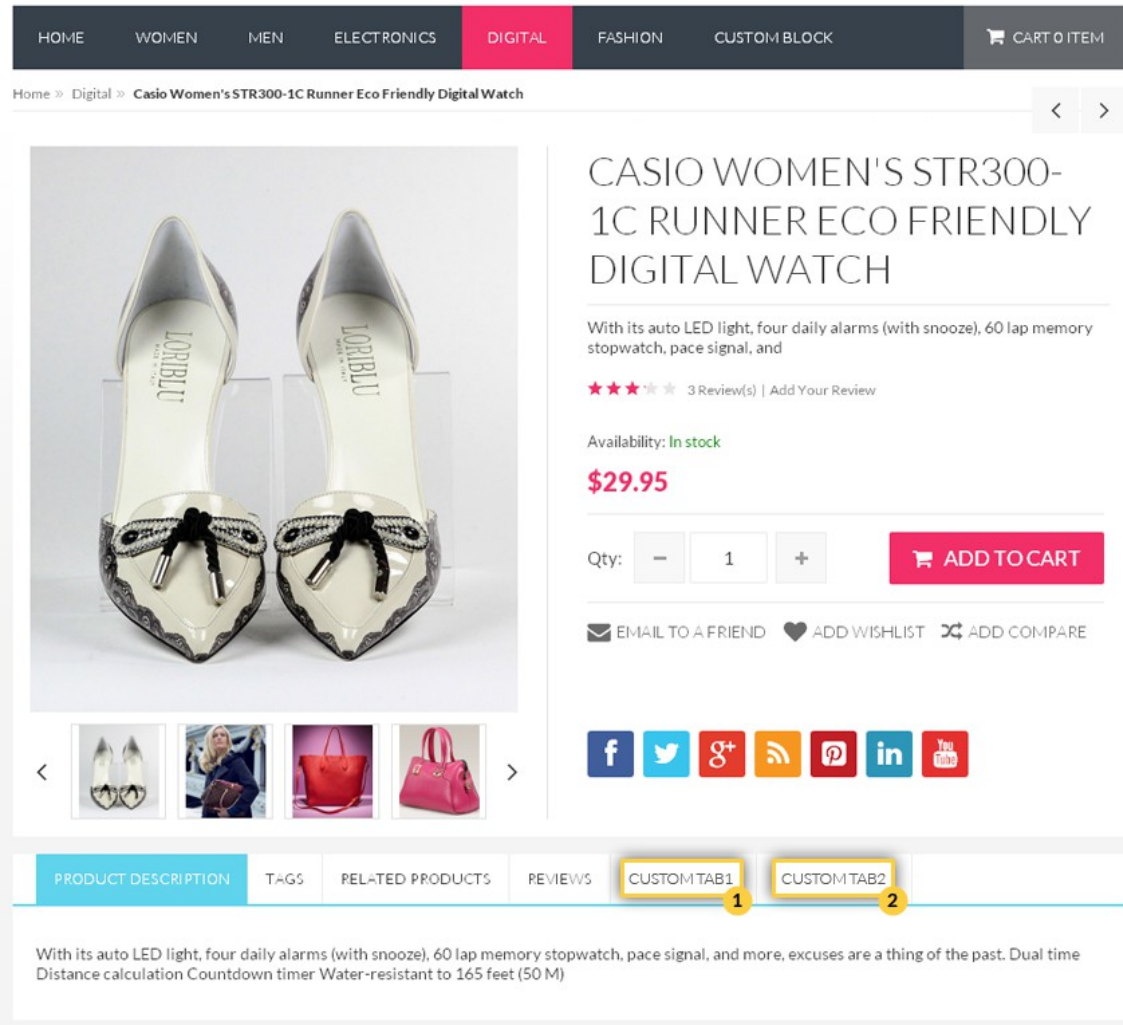


1. **rolta_empty_category** – block above the products listing, displayed if there are no products in the current category. You can use the following template to display a message:

5.3.5 Product page

The following block identifiers can be used to display blocks on the product page:



1. [rolta_custom_tab1](#) – first custom tab. Note that the block title will be displayed as the Custom tab1.
2. [rolta_custom_tab2](#) – second custom tab. Note that the block title will be displayed as the Custom tab2.

6. Troubleshooting

1. I'm getting 404 not found when trying to open theme admin pages.

Log out from Magento admin panel, clear the store cache under var/cache, and log in again.

2. After the extension installation the store gives an error, or blank page.

Log out from Magento admin panel. Change the owner of the extracted extension files to the web server user and set 775 permissions on them. Clear the store cache and try again.

3. There is no Theme Admin in configuration section, or I get a blank page, or Access Denied error.

Log out from Magento admin panel, clear the store cache under var/cache, clear all browser cookies for your store domain and log in again.

4. My configuration changes do not appear on the frontend.

Clear the store cache under var/cache, clear all browser cookies for your store domain and refresh the page in your browser.

5. Some of the theme features don't work or give errors. What can cause the problem?

- a) Magento cache (or external cache) was not flushed after installation of the theme.
- b) Compilation mode was not disabled before installation.
- c) Some of the theme files were not uploaded.
- d) File permissions issue.
- e) You have some third-party extensions which change/break theme's default behavior or cause some conflicts. Extensions such as Fooman Speedster can break the JavaScript files – refer to chapter for more details.
- f) You edited theme files and accidentally removed or changed something in the files.
- g) You have customized the theme by creating custom sub-theme and your modifications change/break the default behavior of the theme.
- h) You have some elements that left from your previous theme (e.g. in Magento's "base" theme in app/design/frontend/base/) and that changes/breaks the default behavior of the theme.

Also check your log files in var/log/ (log settings should be enabled in System > Config > Developer) for more information about possible errors.

6. One of my extensions doesn't work with this theme.

This theme may not be compatible with some third-party extensions. It's impossible for theme author to make the theme compatible by default with all existing extensions because there are thousands of available Magento extensions. Generally all extensions can work with all themes but sometimes they have to be integrated manually. That's because sometimes the extension and the theme override the same Magento template file so there can be a conflict.

7. One of the features stopped working after third-party extension was installed.

There can be a conflict, if the extension and the theme override the same Magento template file. You should contact author of the extension for more information. Also, check your log files in var/log/ (log settings should be enabled in System > Config > Developer) for more information about the error.

8. How to add Layered Navigation to category pages?

To add layered navigation to category pages go to app/design/frontend/rwd/rolta/layout/local.xml and comment this line "<remove name='catalog.leftnav'/>" around line no 24.

9. How to remove Bestseller Products & Featured Products from home page?

In admin panel Go to **CMS -> Pages -> "Rolta Home Page"** content section.
